A few reminders for the new term.....

- Bag contents Children's bags brought into pre-school should only contain items needed for the session like change of shoes/ clothes, drinks and items linked to theme or letter of the week for show and tell. For all children's safety please ensure that very small toys, coins, make up and food items are not left in bags or brought into the session.
- Labelling Please ensure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name and use bag tags provided.
- Outdoor play As we are going outside every day when possible children need indoor and outdoor shoes or wellies.
- <u>Jewellery</u> children should not wear any jewellery apart from small stud earrings.

Payment of Fees

Please remember unless you have agreed alternative arrangements with Michelle fees are payable in the first 2 weeks of term. Prompt payment is always appreciated as chasing fees is our least favourite thing to do!!

Tapestry online

Our Tapestry system to record your child's progress and achievements is always available for you to view online. Children new this term have been entered onto the Tapestry system and parents should have received an email asking them to set up their password in order to access their child's learning journal. When you get the opportunity to look at your child's journal we would appreciate it if you would add your comments. If you have any photos from over the holiday period you could add them too.

Key Person

Your child's key person will introduce themselves and as some staff do not work every day we use a "buddy" system and the name of your 2nd key person is included on the introductory note. Some children who were with us last year may have a new key person but you will be informed if this is the case.

Rising 5's Homework

The aim of the optional activity sheets will be explained in a letter to all rising 5's in the next half term.

In case adverse weather the pre-school plans to remain open unless there is any problem with the premises or enough staff cannot get to work safely. If this happens an email will be sent to parents and a message will be posted on our website www.little-ducks.co.uk.
